#### LOT:

1. Calf-Sept 2017-April 15, 2018
2. Yearling-Aug 2016-July 2017
3. Two-Yr Old - Jan-July 2016

### CLASS C MARKET STEER/HEIFER

Premiums:  
\$20, \$18, \$16, \$14, \$12

#### LOT:

1. Market Steer - Any Breed

### CLASS D SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship classes to follow  
at the end of the beef show.

#### LOT:

1. Junior - Grade 3-5
2. Intermediate - Grade 6-8
3. Senior - Grade 9-12

### CLASS E GROUP CLASSES

Premiums:  
\$20, \$18, \$16

#### LOT:

1. Produce of Dam-two animals,  
either sex, from one dam, to  
be shown in individual classes  
to be eligible. May be shown  
by more than one exhibitor.
2. Junior Get of Sire - three  
animals all by one sire, both  
sexes to be represented. May  
be shown by more than one  
exhibitor. All animals must be  
shown in their individual  
classes to be eligible.
3. Get of Sire - four animals, all  
by one sire, both sexes to be  
represented. May be owned  
by one or more than one  
exhibitor. All animals must be  
shown in individual classes to  
be eligible. This get must  
have a minimum of two  
animals born before  
September 1, 2014 for the  
group to be eligible for the get  
of sire competition.
4. 5 Head - five animals of either  
sex, owned by exhibitor from  
either the calf classes, junior  
classes or senior classes or  
any combination.
5. Breeder's Herd - four animals,  
either sex, bred and owned  
by exhibitor. All animals must  
be shown in their individual  
classes to be eligible.

### CLASS F PROSPECT CALF

Premiums:  
\$16, \$14, \$12, \$10

#### LOT:

1. Any calf (heifer or steer)  
born on/after Jan 1, 2018
