#### LOT:

1. Produce of Dam-two animals,  
either sex, from one dam, to  
be shown in individual classes  
to be eligible. May be shown  
by more than one exhibitor.
2. Junior Get of Sire - three  
animals all by one sire, both  
sexes to be represented. May  
be shown by more than one  
exhibitor. All animals must be  
shown in their individual  
classes to be eligible.
3. Get of Sire - four animals, all  
by one sire, both sexes to be  
represented. May be owned  
by one or more than one  
exhibitor. All animals must be  
shown in individual classes to  
be eligible. This get must  
have a minimum of two  
animals born before  
September 1, 2014 for the  
group to be eligible for the get  
of sire competition.
4. 5 Head - five animals of either  
sex, owned by exhibitor from  
either the calf classes, junior  
classes or senior classes or  
any combination.
5. Breeder's Herd - four animals,  
either sex, bred and owned  
by exhibitor. All animals must  
be shown in their individual  
classes to be eligible.

1. Any Breed

**CLASS B BREEDING**

\$15, \$13, \$11, \$9, \$7

**LOT:**

1. Yearling Ram (Over 1 yr and under 2 yr)
2. Spring Ram (Born after Jan 1, 2018)
3. Yearling Ewe (Over 1 yr and under 2 yr)
4. January Ewe Lamb (Born between Jan 1, 2018 and Jan 31, 2018)
5. February Ewe Lamb ( Born between Feb 1, 2018 and Feb 28, 2018)
6. March Ewe Lamb (Born between Mar 1, 2018 and Mar 31, 2018)

**CLASS C GROUP CLASSES**

\$10, \$8, \$6, \$5, \$4

**LOT:**

1. Exhibitors Flock-Shall consist of 1 Ram-any age, 2 yearling ewes and 2 ewe lambs
2. Pair of Rams - the pair can consist of either 2 ram lambs or 2 yearling rams (Max 2 pair per exhibitor)
3. Pair of Yearling Ewes - (Max 2 pairs per exhibitor)
4. Pair of Ewe Lambs - (Max 2 pairs per exhibitor)

**NOTES:**

1. The judge for each class with the exception of market animals will judge sheep

according to its breed standards. The judge will then place all sheep by how they represent their breed standards that day.

2. If entries are not sufficient to the number in the class, the superintendent(s) will at their discretion divide or combine classes as they see necessary.
3. No one exhibitor may enter no more than 8 animals per class.
4. All lambs shown in lamb class must show lamb teeth.
5. All animals MUST have scrappie tag.
6. No ewe can be shown in a market class and a breeding class.
7. All sheep competing in group classes MUST be shown in regular breed classes.



**DEPARTMENT 6 POULTRY**

**NO TESTING WILL BE DONE AT THE FAIR**

**Entry forms, blood test or hatchery statement MUST be received by Monday, July 23, 2018.**

**Check In:** Tuesday, July 31 from Noon to 6pm and Wednesday, August 1 from Noon to 6pm.

**Judging:** Friday, August 3 at 9am

**Release:** Sunday, August 5 at 5pm. Not responsible for birds left after 6pm on Sunday, August 5, 2018

**POULTRY:**

**EXCEPT WATERFOWL/PIGEONS**

Accompanied by an official form identifying the fowl by using a leg or wire band and with a record of a negative test for pullorum-typhoid conducted within 90 days prior to entry to the exhibition or a record of origin from parent stock tested negative within 12 months prior to entry to the exhibition. Turkeys must be tested at a laboratory for typhimurium and mycoplasmas or have a statement of origin if less than 5 months old.
